

MILLENNIUM MANIFEST "OUR WORLD"

1. The U.N. Assembly to proclaim millennium year 2000 as U.N. World Family Year.
2. To proclaim the U.N. World Family Year as a Sabbatical Year in which the rich industrial countries, the Euro Bank, the I.M.F and the World Bank grant a moratorium on the debts of the poor countries.
3. To found a special U.N. World Family Tax Fund to benefit the underdeveloped countries, with the aim of preventing and/or combatting the results of the developments as described in The Report of the Club of Rome, the predictions of the World Meteorological Organisation and the International Red Cross (sept.'99 Seminar, under the auspices of the U.N. Social Economic Council), and the request by Kofi Annan on the eve of World Population Day on July 11th 1999 (population density, climate changes and environmental damage).
4. To introduce a voluntary global contribution of U.S. 10 \$ a month per U.N. tax payer in favour of the U.N. World Family Tax Fund, supplemented by the four parties mentioned under 2 above.
Potential Income: 1200 billion U.S. \$ a year (2 billion U.N.-taxpayers x 12 x(5x10)).
5. To elect, in conjunction with the European (continental) elections, U.N. Assembly Senators for the Environment with responsibility to implement policies towards:
"Our World", a home for all of us, in solidarity with people, animals and environment in deprived situations.
